Child Sexual Assault Investigation & Prosecution: From A - Z

This training is brought to you through a joint effort of the Children's Law Center and the South Carolina Commission on Prosecution Coordination.

Overview: This training is for law enforcement officers, prosecutors, and victim advocates. The training will walk the participants through both the investigation and prosecution phases of child sexual assault cases. Topics will include preservation and documentation of the scene, minimal facts reporting, South Carolina Child Advocacy Centers, medical aspects of child sexual abuse, corroboration of the forensic interview, case preparation, pre-text phone calls, forensic evidence, Lyle evidence, post-trial motions, and sentencing issues.

Who should attend? Law Enforcement, Prosecutors, and Victim Advocates
