Emergency Protective Custody for Law Enforcement

Who should attend: This training is designed for law enforcement and/or DSS caseworkers or investigators who will have direct duties and responsibilities surrounding the EPC process.

Overview: Emergency Protective Custody for Law Enforcement will provide frontline law enforcement officer on their statutory obligations related to abused or neglected children, including their responsibilities as mandatory reporters and their authority to exercise Emergency Protective Custody. The training will include indicators of abuse and neglect, coordination with DSS, and the interactions with children and parents. It will provide guidelines for minimizing trauma, and an explanation of court proceedings and the officer's role providing testimony regarding probable cause.
