



Child Death/Homicide Investigations

Overview: This is an 18 hour interactive lecture for law enforcement patrol officers, detectives, crime scene investigators and coroner's office investigators. Topics discussed will be the different manners of child death, crime scene response and documentation, interview techniques, forensic and medical information, case management, and court preparation. Sudden Unexpected Death in Infancy, Abusive Head Trauma, Medical Child Abuse and Battered Child Syndrome will be discussed. Students will be able to recognize and address the complexities of investigating child homicides.
