



SRO SUMMER CONFERENCE 2018

Overview: This conference is designed for school resource officers who we recognize as having an important role in protecting the children in our state.

- This training will provide tools and information which will assist in recognizing child physical and sexual abuse and neglect.
- SRO's are likely to encounter students who harm themselves yet deny suicidal intent. This training will address this behavior, called Non-Suicidal Self Injury (NSSI), and will discuss its prevalence and purpose, as well as how to help a self-injuring student.
- During a session on Crisis Prevention and Intervention, SRO's will learn how to defuse challenging and disruptive behavior before an incident escalates into a crisis situation.
- Other topics to be discussed are mandated reporting, emergency protective custody, minimal facts interviews, social media and sexting.

The goal of this training is to provide school resource officers with a more in-depth knowledge of abuse, neglect, exploitation, victimization, and related dynamics of one of our most vulnerable populations.
