If you have any contact with children, adolescents, and their families - as part of your profession or your volunteer work - they have absolutely everything to do with you. Participants will:

- 1) be provided with and will receive training on **The Core Competencies of Trauma-Informed Care for Agencies and Organizations in South Carolina that Serve Children, Adolescents, and Their Families**. This framework has been adopted by the South Carolina Joint Council on Children and Adolescents.
- 2) receive a detailed explanation of the standards, relevant to trauma, to be expected in terms of knowledge, values and attitudes, communication, practice, organizations and systems, and communities.
- 3) be given the model for how we all in South Carolina – individuals, professionals, stakeholders, and communities - will respond to children, adolescents, and families who have encountered traumatic events.
