

## **Regional Attorney Trainer** (Administrative Manager I)

Under the supervision of the Lead Attorney Trainer, develops and conducts regional and statewide legal training for Department of Social Services child welfare and legal staff. In selected counties assigned to this position, assesses needs and develops and conducts targeted training. Position requires frequent travel within designated counties and occasional travel to other parts of the state.

**Minimum qualifications** include a law degree, membership in the S.C. Bar, and five years of experience as a practicing attorney in family court, including child protection proceedings. Must have substantial knowledge of federal and state child protection statutes, related case law, court rules, and practices. Must be familiar with DSS programs and procedures.

**Preferred qualifications** include prior training or teaching experience.
